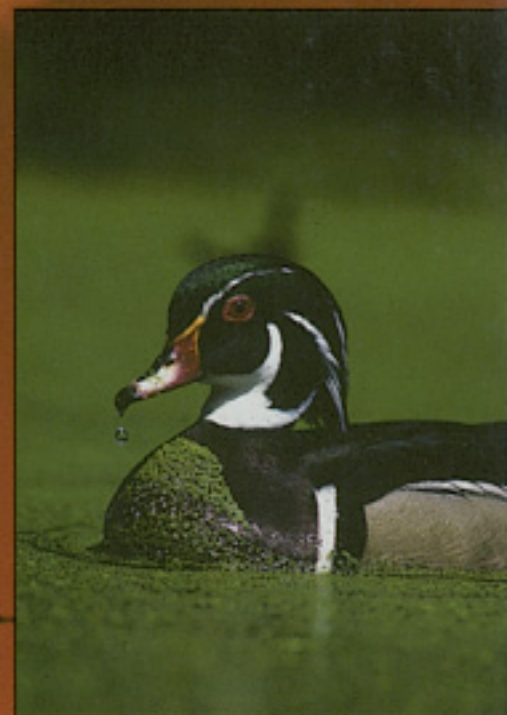

The Waterfowl Images of Joe Mac Hudspeth, Jr.

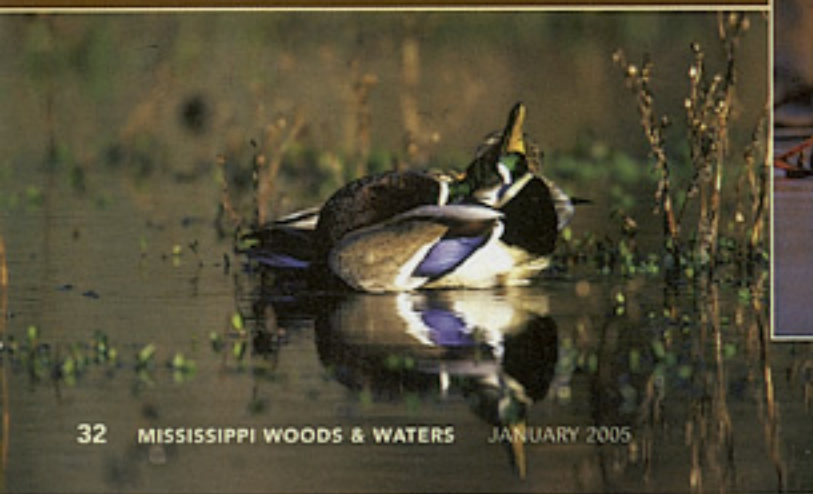
